

PowerFilm REACH Statement

Dear Valued Customer,

In June 2007, the European Union Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) was first released. This Regulation establishes specific duties and obligations for companies in the European Union (EU) that manufacture or import substances on their own, in preparations, or in articles. Under the definition of the REACH regulations EC1907/2006, PowerFilm, Inc is a producer of "articles". PowerFilm does not manufacture or supply "substances" or "preparations" and our "articles" do not involve "intentional release of substances". Therefore no registration or pre-registration is required for the product we supply to you.

REACH requires "article" suppliers to inform recipients if an article contains a Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) in excess of 0.1% by weight. Based on the material content certifications provided by PowerFilm's suppliers, none of these substances are present in the materials we use in our Electronic Component solar panels, including packing and shipping materials. Therefore, PowerFilm products do not contain any of these SVHC in excess of 0.1% by weight.

PowerFilm Electronic Component solar panels do not contain and SVHC above the threshold value declared as per ECHA till January 16, 2019 with 197 SVHCs.
